



DriverLINX Update Information

How do I tell what version I have? From the Start Menu, go to Programs and select DriverLINX and then select "About DriverLINX". Pick your driver name from the drop down box and then click OK. The dialog that displays will indicate the version (screen shot below).



The version information above indicates the installation of DriverLINX for the CTM series of board. The A01 release of the CD was used (current release). The final digit (.0.0.1) indicates that a patch has been applied to the installation.

DriverLINX driver updates

Updates to DriverLINX CDs are distributed in a self installing file. The installer will check for prior installation of the correct version of DriverLINX for which the update is intended. If you do not have that version of DriverLINX installed, the update will indicate this to you and will not make any changes to your system.

When the installer does update your system, the full release notes associated with this update are available in a text file located in the DriverLINX installation directory: `:\drvlinx4\system\`. Also, the release notes are available for on-line reading in the software downloads section of the Keithley web site.
