OVERVIEW

<u>CVE-2021-44228</u> was published December 10th, 2021, in regards to an Apache Log4j2 2.0-beta9 through 2.15.0 vulnerability allowing an attacker to control log messages or log message parameters to execute arbitrary code loaded from LDAP servers when message lookup substitution is enabled.

PSIRT STATEMENT

The Log4J security vulnerability (CVE-2021-44228) that has received a considerable amount of recent press coverage.

We want to assure you that we are aware of the issue and have taken immediate and robust steps to fully understand any implications for our systems and the systems upon which our products and services rely.

Our assessment has not identified the vulnerability in any Tektronix products, and we do not have any reason to believe that it has been used to compromise any Tektronix products.

At this juncture, we believe that we have taken the necessary and recommended steps to safeguard our systems in light of this threat.
