#### **Unresolved Software Defects**

■ Site Controller gets "No further info available" after conflict check (GVGaa07815).

After adding a reservation via Site Controller, you may get the message "No further info available." Even though the reservation passes conflict check, it is in the database and the session runs.

■ Two alarm ports allowed (GVGaa08139).

You can modify an alarm port, which results in two alarm ports being saved into the DB. When entering new ports, only one alarm port is allowed.

Archived Reservation Report should show weekdays (GVGaa07748).
Archived reservation report should print out the days of the week when the reservation ran.
