

# HC7B Transit Case Instructions

## Case description



The HC7B transit case protects the 7 Series DPO instrument from shock, vibration, and moisture. The case contains engineered foam cutouts for the instrument and power cord, an automatic air pressure equalization control valve for use during air transport, and security rings for use with locks (locks not included).

1. Retractable extension trolley handle
2. Interior engineered foam: Polyethylene (layers), polyurethane (lid and bottom)
3. Automatic air pressure relief / breather valve
4. Easy open double throw latches (6) with locking hasps (2)
5. Polyurethane wheels with stainless steel bearings
6. Large 2-person fold down handles
7. Impact-resistant/UV stabilized polypropylene case
8. Security rings

The case loaded with one instrument, power cord, and fully loaded accessories softcase weighs less than 130 lbs (59 kg) shipping weight.





## Packing instructions

The transit case consists of a heavy duty outer shell and an inner layer of engineered foam with instrument and power cord cutouts. The included soft case provides storage for the instrument accessories.

### Pack the instrument

**WARNING:** The product is heavy. To reduce the risk of personal injury or damage to the device, get help when lifting or carrying the product.



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1. Remove all accessories and the power cord from the instrument.
2. Place the power cord in the indicated cutout in the transit case.
3. Place the accessories in the appropriate cutouts in the soft case. See the case identification card (or the image on the previous page) for locations.
4. Slip the accessories case between the instrument handles as indicated. You can place it on either side.
5. Collapse the instrument feet.
6. Install the front cover on the instrument.

### Case transport

Tip the case up, wheels side down, and extend the handle to allow for easy transport.
